Cricket has been played at Jeffrey Field since 1877 and the current club was formed in 1882 following the merging of the two clubs in the village at that time to form one 'united' team. The club has made fantastic developments in recent years and we are looking to improve the facilities further to engage the local community in healthy activities and social events.

The Club has a thriving junior section and our dedicated team of qualified coaches and volunteers encourage young children from the age of 5 to learn the game and compete against their peers. We have junior teams playing competitive cricket at U9, U11, U13 and U15 levels in the Heavy Woollen District Junior Cricket League and we are incredibly proud to have a large number of juniors' graduate to play senior cricket at the club to further their progression.

We were recently reaccredited with Sport England "Clubmark" status – confirming the Club as being a beacon for junior cricket development with an excellent standard of administration, organisation and child welfare. The club is also involved in the ECB 'All Stars' programme to introduce 5 to 8-year-olds to the game of cricket and the 'Last Man Stands' initiative to attract ex-players and social teams to a shorter form of the game.

On the field, we have three senior teams – two playing in the Bradford Premier League (1st & 2nd teams) and one in the Mid-Yorkshire Sunday League covering West Yorkshire. We also reached the last 16 in the National Village Cup in 2018, which saw us travel up to Scotland where our run sadly ended. We are a club run entirely by volunteers and any sponsor money the club receives goes directly into the development and improving our facilities for our teams and for the wider community. Last year, our third Beer Festival was again a huge success and – along with our annual Bonfire and Firework Night – we saw lots of new faces down at the club.

Our facilities are available to hire either for social events or to hold an inter-company match. Please come down to the club and have a look, have a drink and/or watch some cricket.
